Speakers (alphabetical order)

Andrius Jurkonis, Axia Capital Fund (Lithuania)

Andrius is the fund manager of Axia Capital Fund. He focuses on value-oriented public equities and private investments mostly in the US, Europe, and CEE. He has been an active manager for over 10 years while previously he held management positions in retail, utilities, commercial and investment banking. Andrius is a CFA Charterholder while he received his masters and undergraduate degrees from Vilnius University.

Andreas Assiotis, Hellenic Bank (Cyprus)

Dr Assiotis is Group Chief Economist of Hellenic Bank. He is also a visiting scholar at the University of Cyprus and a member of the National Economic and Competitiveness Council of Cyprus. Dr. Assiotis has held several positions including a professorship and consultancy positions both domestically and internationally. He also served as the editor in chief for the Journal of World Economic Review as well as a contributing Editor for the Anti-Corruption Research Network, Transparency International. He received his BA in Management Information Systems, an MA in Economics, and his PhD in Economics from the Southern Illinois University USA. He has published in several influential journals in the areas of macroeconomics, economic development and growth and financial economics.

Arimatti Alhanko, Banque Havilland (Luxembourg)

Arimatti is a senior investment advisor at Banque Havilland, a family-owned private bank based in Luxembourg, where he advises and manages client's wealth. Since joining Banque Havilland in May 2018, Arimatti has launched two equity portfolios. Previously he worked as an equity portfolio manager and an equity analyst at Nordea in Luxembourg and Sweden. Arimatti also served as a derivatives trader at Pyne Trading in the UK, and as a summer intern in asset management at OP Financial Group in Finland. Arimatti holds a MSc in Engineering from the Aalto University and a MSc in Finance from the Oulu Business School.

Arko Kadajane, Ambient Sound Investments (Estonia)

Arko is responsible for ASI's Listed Equity investments, investing ASI's stock portfolio based on value-investing principles. Investments are made into different sectors except for non-ethical industries. He also plays the key role working out ASI's overall portfolio and investments strategy. As Arko has been involved in stock markets since 1996 and has previously worked in the fields of private equity as well as listed equity, he has extensive expertise in the qualitative and quantitative business factors.

Bogumil K. Baranowski, Sicart Associates (U.S.A.)

Bogumil K. Baranowski is a New York City-based investment professional with almost 15 years of experience. He is a founding partner of Sicart Associates, a boutique investment firm catering to families and entrepreneurs on both sides of the Atlantic and the Pacific. He is the author of *Outsmarting the Crowd – A Value Investor's Guide to Starting, Building and Keeping a Family Fortune* (2015), and the upcoming *Money, Life, Family, My Handbook* (2019) - My Complete Collection of Principles on Investing, Finding Work-Life Balance, and Preserving Family Wealth. He is a TEDx Speaker ("The Great Investor in You"). He holds a Master's degree in Finance and Strategy from Institut d'Etudes Politiques de Paris (Sciences Po), and a Master's in Finance and Banking from Warsaw School of Economics. Bogumil was born in Poland, and currently lives in New York City. In his free time he reads, writes, flies single-engine propeller planes, scuba dives around the globe, and sails.

Brad Lindenbaum, Stone Forest Capital (U.S.A.)

Brad Lindenbaum is the Chief Investment Officer and founder of Stone Forest Capital, LLC. Prior to founding Stone Forest in September 2014, Mr. Lindenbaum worked for over seven years at Neon Liberty Capital, a global emerging markets equities hedge fund with \$1.7 billion in AUM. At Neon Liberty, Mr. Lindenbaum was the Portfolio Manager responsible for Greater China, and invested in long and short positions around the world in Neon's hedge fund and long-only fund. Mr. Lindenbaum was also the lead Portfolio Manager on the Wei Ji Fund, a global emerging markets equities "net net" fund. Prior to Neon, Mr. Lindenbaum was a global generalist with a focus on Asia and China at AllianceBernstein L.P. Before AllianceBernstein, Mr. Lindenbaum was a founding member of BDC Financial, a

financial services start-up, an Associate in the Financial Institutions Group of Wasserstein Perella & Co., Inc, and an Investment Analyst at International Finance Corporation (IFC) in the China, Mongolia, Korea, and the Philippines Division. Mr. Lindenbaum began his professional career as an Emerging Asia equities Analyst at CS First Boston (Hong Kong) Ltd. and taught at the Foreign Affairs College (Beijing). Mr. Lindenbaum holds a MBA from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania and a Bachelor of the Arts from Princeton University, where he studied East Asian economic development at the Woodrow Wilson School of Public & International Affairs and earned a Certificate in East Asian Studies. Mr. Lindenbaum is fluent in Mandarin Chinese.

Chaitanya Dalmia, Renaissance Group (India)

After graduation, Chaitanya did his MBA from Indian affiliate of IMD, Lausanne. Early in his career, he did various stints in group manufacturing concerns. He then undertook courses covering 'Business Analysis and Valuation', and 'Financial Markets' at the London School of Economics (LSE) before moving onto become the CIO of Renaissance (family office) since 2000. His current role encapsulates macro-economic environment scan, corporate structures, corporate finance, legal and taxation, equity investing, structured debt, asset allocation, and risk optimisation. He writes for Outlook Business and was covered in Forbes (India) "Wealth Wizards: Top 20 investors".

Charalambos Prountzos, EY (Cyprus)

Charalambos Prountzos is the Managing Partner of Prountzos & Prountzos LLC – EY Law, a leading Cyprus law firm and member firm of EY Global since April 2017. He has been recently appointed EY Law leader for the Central, Eastern and Southeastern Europe & Central Asia (CESA) region. He is the Chairman of the Board of the Open University of Cyprus, a Board Member of RISE, Cyprus' largest research project and a member of the Board of the Cyprus Investment Funds Association. He studied law at the University of Bristol, concluded the Bar Vocational Course at the Inns of Court School of Law in London and is a Member of Gray's Inn. He is a practicing lawyer and a Member of the Cyprus Bar Association. He is the leader of the Funds Services of EY in Cyprus and has advised Cypriot and international clients on many fields of law.

Christopher Karlin, Aquitania Capital Management (U.S.A.)

Christopher Karlin is the Chief Investment Officer at Aquitania Capital Management in Austin, Texas. Prior to founding Aquitania in 2012, he was a member of the investment teams at First Pacific Advisors, Kestrel Investment Management, Fairview Capital Investment Management, and Farallon Capital Management. Christopher received his BBA from the University of Wisconsin, his MBA from Yale University, and is a Chartered Financial Analyst.

Christopher Detweiler, Veraison Capital (Switzerland)

Dr. Detweiler is a co-founder of Veraison, a Swiss asset manager that runs a focused portfolio of Swiss companies that are undervalued and misunderstood by the capital markets. In addition to analyzing Swiss Equities, Christopher has four years of experience engaging with European companies to create value through full-scale transformations, as well as targeted strategic, operational and financial projects. Previously, he was a Project Leader at The Boston Consulting Group (Switzerland) AG, where he worked from 2011-2015 in the Consumer & Industrial Goods practice areas. Prior to that, he began his career analyzing Swiss Equities and macroeconomic trends at Wellershoff & Partners. Christopher has a PhD in Chinese Studies from Freiburg University. He is married and father of three children.

Christos Spanos, Wealth Guardian (Cyprus)

Christos Spanos has been in the investment business since the mid-nineties. He holds a number of board seats at Financial Services companies and funds, as well as acting as an adviser to various private entities and HNWIs. Throughout his career, he founded and managed a number of outfits in the wealth management and fund management sphere. He manages private portfolios primarily following quantitative strategies as well as running a private commercial real estate company. He holds an MBA and an MSc in Medical Radiation Physics and has a BSc (Hon) in Physics. He is a CFA Charterholder.

Daniel Glaser, River Oak Capital (Sweden)

Daniel Glaser is the Founder and CEO of River Oak Capital AB, a private investment company based in Uppsala, Sweden. He also manages his own family office since 2013. Both entities use the same approach and have taken inspiration from Allan Mecham, Pat Dorsey, Phil Fisher and of course the usual suspects from Berkshire. Besides investing, Daniel has also been the CEO of a small health app company called Nutris AB in Sweden where he remains as Chairman. He has a Master's Degree in Engineering Physics from the Royal Institute of Technology in Stockholm. In 2005 he did his Master's Thesis at a startup called ViewRay where he built a software that optimizes radiation treatment plans for cancer patients. ViewRay now offers the world's first MRI-guided real-time adaptive radiotherapy and was listed on the Nasdaq in 2016.

David Kessler, Robotti & Company (U.S.A.)

David Kessler is a Senior Investment Associate with Robotti & Company Advisors, LLC. Prior to joining Robotti & Company, David was a Research Analyst Consultant with Aquamarine Capital and held portfolio management roles with Rochdale Investment Management and Morgan Stanley. David received an MBA from Columbia Business School and was a member of Columbia's Applied Value Investing Program. As an MBA student, David co-launched Columbia's first student-run investment newsletter, "Graham and Doddsville." He also gained valuable experience as a summer intern with Ruane, Cunniff & Goldfarb (Sequoia Fund). David graduated from the University of Maryland with a B.S. in Finance and Marketing.

Dominic Fisher, Thistledown Investment Management (U.K.)

Dominic has been investing since 1989. He trained at Hambros Bank, joining Mercury Asset Management in 1992. There he led the charities team which successfully resisted the pressure to invest in a 'new era' during the dotcom boom. He established Thistledown in 2009 and has managed the VT Thistledown Income Fund since its inception in 2010. He was awarded the OBE in 2015 for his charitable work for armed forces personnel and is currently a mentor for "Supporting Wounded Veterans". He is a director of Aberforth Split Level Income Trust Plc. and a founder member of the Value Investors Special Interest Group of the CFA Society of the UK.

Gerrard Murray, Private Investor (Ireland)

Gerard is consultant engineer specialising in the energy industry, his background is in subsea oil and gas engineering where he worked with super major oil companies such as Chevron upstream Europe and Aker BP. Gerard is also a technical advisor into the insurance industry where he specialises in renewable energy risk management and the implementation of operational efficiencies. Gerard has a BEng from Technological University Dublin, a MSc in Oil and Gas Management from Aberdeen University and a Dip in Business Finance from Smurfit Business School, University College Dublin.

John Zolidis, Quo Vadis Capital (U.S.A.)

John Zolidis is the Founder and President of Quo Vadis Capital, Inc. Mr. Zolidis formed Quo Vadis in 2017 to provide high-quality research on the restaurant and retail industries for institutional investors as well as consulting services to companies in the industries. Previous to founding Quo Vadis, Mr. was a sell-side analyst at Buckingham Research covering retail and restaurants. Mr. Zolidis also served as a buy-side consumer analyst at Buckingham Capital Management, a long-short hedge fund. He was with Buckingham since 2001. He was added to the Wall Street Journal's "Best on the Street" list in 2005 for the Specialty Stores category. Prior to Buckingham, he got his start on Wall Street at Sidoti & Co. and Morgan Stanley. His undergraduate studies were at Mansfield College, Oxford and Kenyon College where he graduated with a degree in Philosophy. Mr. Zolidis currently resides in Paris, France with his wife and two daughters.

Kevin Smith, Crescat Capital LLC (U.S.A.)

Kevin Smith is the founder and CIO of Crescat Capital, a global macro asset management firm. Crescat develops tactical investment themes based on proprietary value-driven models. Kevin has 21 years of portfolio management experience. He is the inventor of Crescat's firmwide global macro investment process and its systematic equity valuation model. He holds an MBA from the University of Chicago, Booth School of Business with a specialization in

finance and concentration in statistics. Kevin earned his undergraduate degree in economics from Stanford University and holds the Chartered Financial Analyst designation.

Michalis Florentiades, XM (Cyprus)

Michalis Florentiades is the Chief Economist and Head of Investment Research for XM, an online financial services company. He began his career in London as a Financial Economist before returning to Cyprus and Hellenic Bank where he was Head of Research. At Hellenic, he wrote the book "Economic Review of 2004-2011"; a collection of research articles on Cyprus and the Global Economy during that period. Mr. Florentiades has a BSc in Economics from the London School of Economics (LSE), Master's degree in Mathematical Trading and Finance from the City University Business School and is a CFA Charterholder.

Ole Sjøberg, Nordic Investment Partners (Denmark)

Ole founded Nordic Investment Partners in 2017 and offers investment advice to family trusts. A fund run by Ole and with absolute return focus is planned to be launched later in 2018. He began his career in 1984 when he founded Dansk Aktie Analyse (independent research boutique in Copenhagen). In 1985 he worked for Privatbanken in international equities. In the 1990's he was head of international equities in Denmark for Carnegie and Alfred Berg. He worked as head of Investor relations for Denmark's TDC (1999-2005) and Tryg Insurance (2006-2010). From 2011-17 he was fund manager and Chief Investment Officer in Skagen funds, Norway. Ole has an MBA from Copenhagen Business School.

Olga Kandinskaia, Cyprus International Institute of Management (Cyprus)

Olga Kandinskaia is Assistant Professor of Finance and MSc Business Management Director at the CIIM, Cyprus International Institute of Management. Originally from Moscow, Russia, Olga has PhD in Economics (1995) from the prestigious MGIMO-University. Olga's PhD research was in the area of financial derivatives as risk management tools. At that time, she also had practical experience of working as a futures broker. Olga has 25+ years of experience in teaching undergraduate, MBA and executive courses. Her current expertise is in the areas of Financial Management, Business Planning, Strategic Investment Decisions, Corporate Finance, and Business Valuation. Her teaching philosophy is to deliver interactive, customized and practically relevant learning where theory is applied to real-life cases. Olga herself is an experienced case writer and has received two prestigious awards for case writing. In 2017, Olga won the top prize in the international competition by The Case Centre in the category 'Outstanding New Case Writer', and in 2018, Olga won the NACRA conference award for the Best Case in Accounting, Finance and Economics. Both awards were first-time wins for Cyprus.

He became a full time investor in 2013. Opportunities are sourced mostly in Europe and the US, and are sector and size agnostic. Previously Paolo has been an executive in the Pharmaceutical industry in the US, UK and Italy and then a senior partner at Egon Zehnder, one of the largest Executive Search and Management Consulting Firms in the world. He holds an MBA from Columbia Business School and an undergraduate degree in Economics from the University of Rome.

Samir Mohamed, Family Fund (Switzerland/Cyprus)

Samir started with value investing in 1999 and manages a private family fund, full time, for the last few years. He focuses on good businesses with temporary problems and suppressed stock prices. Samir enjoys collaborating with other value investors regularly via in-person meetings or Skype calls. Samir was global head of the product management teams of a € 170m industrial business at Siemens. He worked at Siemens for 13 years. He has a master's degree in Management, Technology, and Economics and a bachelor's degree in material science, both from ETH Zurich. He recently relocated from Switzerland to Cyprus.

Simon Caufield, SIM Limited (U.K.)

Simon has been a professional investor since 2007 and manages family capital and has a private client advisory business. He specialises in deep value, cyclical and cheap compounders in the industrial, consumer discretionary and non-bank financial sectors. He is an active member of the value investing special interest group of the CFA in the UK and a regular visitor to value investing events.

Sophocles Sophocleous, FatAlpha (Cyprus)

A Fulbright scholar and Chartered Financial Analyst, Sophocles will take on the role of head of asset management at SPA Financial Services on October 1st, where he will manage the firm's global hard currency bond fund. He also teaches an applied investments course he designed at the Cyprus International Institute of Management and a CFA Level 1 course at the European University Nicosia. On an annual basis, Sophocles organizes the private, by-invitation Cyprus Value Investor Conference where global investors gather to exchange ideas and discuss the markets. Previously, he managed institutional equity portfolios for the Cyprus Development Bank based on his proprietary equity strategy (FatAlpha) and spent over 11 years with London-based Emerging Markets fund manager Argo Capital Management which had a peak AUM of \$3 billion. Sophocles started his career interning at Dean Witter, and then working at Equity Securities in Minneapolis and CNH Capital Markets in Nicosia. He graduated from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign with a double major in Economics and Finance.

Stan Gorozhankin, Vita Markets (Cyprus)

Stan is Managing Director of Limassol-based investment firm VM Vita Markets Ltd, which provides investment solutions for professional investors. He started his career as a sell-side equity research analyst at Renaissance Capital and Bank of America Merrill Lynch, then moved to buy-side by joining as the head of research of a single-family office managing a \$250mn portfolio. Stan holds a BSc in Economics and an MSc in Finance from National Research University – Higher School of Economics, Moscow, and MBA from HEC Paris.
